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## Pub Talk - What *REALLY* happened?



Well, they are not made up. Each of these drawings depicts an actual event that happened at the Pietermaritzburg Aero Club! This is what I have been able to piece together about what happened:

#### ZS-DTP's broken back...



In order to protect the guilty, we won't name names, (truth is I don't know who it was, only that it took place in 1965).

ZS-DTP, which was the Pmb Aero Club's first omni-vision C150, (ie. it had a back window), was effectively removed from action by a brand new PPL student!


It was his *very first flight* as a PPL, and he decided to demonstrate a shortfield take-off off Runway 16 to his very first passenger. The flight was remarkably short as he stalled the aircraft shortly after take-off and dumped it on the runway, breaking it's back in the process. Our errant PPL, having learnt a great deal about the importance of airspeed in maintaining flight, went on to have a career

as a Corporate Jet Pilot.

The omni-vision C150 was introduced by Cessna in 1964. Before this model, C150's had no back window and their tailfins did not slope, but were vertical. ZS-DTP also had a kiddies bench seat in the back.
